MEASURE THE DISTANCE BETWEEN 'CROSS AND RESURRECTION'

Resurrection of Jesus is the fundamental belief of Christian faith upon which Christianity flourished over the years to become a world religion that attracts millions to the faith, until today. Though, many of the Western Churches give more importance to the Cross or passion of Jesus Christ than to Easter, in the Eastern tradition of Christianity, Easter is at the centre of the Church's proclamation. But that doesn't mean that Good Friday is irrelevant in our faith culture. The following is a brief note on how the two Christ events co-relate with each other, and how they form, influence, and nurture the faith of millions of Christian believers, even today.

A Christian priest who visited the Holy Land, particularly, the places associated with the Life, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, narrated his experience of Jerusalem in these words, "What I hadn't realized before this visit was the close proximity of the place of Jesus' Death and Resurrection. As I thought about it, I began to realize how the short distance between these two places is deeply symbolic of a deeper spiritual reality - namely, that our share in Jesus' Cross and Resurrection is not separated by big gaps or time lags but are mostly entwined in the daily experience of Christian Living. Death and Resurrection are really never far apart."

Think for example of someone who is apparently happy in life with much going for them and much to look forward to. Then something happens out of the blue that plunges their world into darkness. These include people who have lost jobs, or loved ones through sudden death, or received a diagnosis of serious illness. One minute, life was great; the next minute it became a nightmare. The journey from light to darkness, from the Empty Tomb back to Calvary, is but a few steps. Or, the change can be in the opposite direction. Think of people who have suffered greatly in their lives, but who have been changed by their experience to become witnesses to Hope. These include people who have endured the Cross, but have not been destroyed by suffering and death. Instead, through their faith and hope they have been transformed into instruments of love and change for good. Examples from history include, St. Maximillian Kolbe who volunteered to die in place of a married man in the hell of Auschwitz; Saint Thérèse of Lisieux who emerged from her experience of

darkness and nothingness during illness, with heroic faith and hope. All of these lives, at some point moved the short distance from the Cross to the Tomb of Christ, where they arose with Him to new lives whose light shines brightly still.

For most of us though, the experience of both Cross and Resurrection is a daily reality. The Cross and Resurrection are mysteries not separated but intertwined. No matter how good things are for us, our lives are never completely free of the Cross. No matter how hard life is, Resurrection is still in progress. The Hope of Christian Life is grounded in the mystery of Jesus' Cross and Resurrection into which we were immersed on the day we were baptized. In the Lord's life, although the Cross and Resurrection took place in time, they were two mysteries that penetrated His life and person at all times. That is why for St. John, in his Gospel, the moment of the Cross is also the moment of Resurrection, the hour of God's glory, of being lifted up - the sublime moment of God's love for the world revealed (John 12:32). It is also the moment of Pentecost with the handing over of His Spirit and the birth of the Church with His blood and water (John 19:30, 34). For St. John, Christ's glory was already shining through His Cross. This was how St. Paul also understood Jesus' death and Resurrection and our share in it. Through baptism, we were immersed in both His Death and Resurrection. Because we participate in both mysteries we are "alive for God in Christ Jesus" and are now living a new life in him (Rom. 6:1ff).

Our hope in the Resurrection changes everything. If you feel trapped within a tomb of worry, undergo great trials and torments of mind or body, perhaps try not to wait for a great day of relief to arrive in the future, but be attentive to how God might be changing you now, into a person of greater love. Though suffering remains, because of our Baptism, Christ has already placed the seeds of the Resurrection in the heart of our darkness. United to Christ we hope and trust that trials will not destroy us but new life will soon be ours again with Him. Sharing in His Resurrection means that the worst thing is never the last thing.

I conclude with the words of C.S. Lewis who once wrote: "Perhaps the most important difference between Christianity and all other religions is that in Christianity God is not a static thing - not even a person, but a dynamic, pulsating activity, a life, almost a kind of drama" (Resurrection). At the heart of

this drama is Jesus’ Suffering and Resurrection in which we share. Neither are ever far away from us, but interpenetrate in my life and yours. Like the Empty Tomb near the Rock of Calvary, hope is just a short step away from every trial through which we triumph by the power of Him who loves us (Rom. 8:37).

“You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in You.” — Isaiah 26:3

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

As we move from April to June 2026, the world remains locked in a slow, grinding grief. The Russia-Ukraine war continues to bury cities under rubble. The Middle East reverberates with the aftershocks of conflict. In Sudan, in Myanmar, in corners the news rarely visits, ordinary people wake to extraordinary suffering. We scroll past it all over morning tea, and something quietly breaks inside us. The question is not whether the world is at war. The question is whether we will let the war move inside.

God’s answer in Isaiah 26:3 is startling in its simplicity. The Hebrew for “perfect peace” is *shalom shalom* - the word doubled, the way a mother repeats a promise to a frightened child. Not peace as the absence of war, but peace as the presence of wholeness. A ceasefire, not out there in the headlines, but in here, in the mind and soul. And the condition? A mind that is leaning its full weight on God, the way you lean against a wall you trust will not move.

The War Nobody Reports

The most consequential war of our time is not being fought on any geographic front. It is being fought inside the human mind. Anxiety, despair, numbness, cynicism - these are the casualties no drone can capture. The enemy does not need to destroy your city. He only needs to destroy your certainty that God is still on the throne. A Ukrainian grandmother, interviewed from a bombed-out apartment, said simply: “I pray the Psalms every morning before I check if the walls are still standing.” She had understood something most of us keep forgetting - the interior life must be fortified before the exterior world can be faced.

What would your daily life look like in this quarter? Perhaps it means opening Scripture before opening your news app. Perhaps it means speaking hope out loud in your home when every headline whispers doom. These are not passive gestures. They are the spiritual equivalent of digging trenches - shaping the ground of your inner life so that peace has somewhere to take root.

As this quarter draws to its close, the Church enters the Apostles’ Fast - June 16 to 29 - one of her oldest and most under-used seasons of prayer.

It was born not as a ritual of restraint but as a posture of readiness. In 2026, this fast arrives at a moment of unusual weight. Consider giving these thirteen days a specific shape: fast one meal a day and use that hour not to pray vaguely, but by name - a nation at war, a grieving family in our Church, a prodigal who needs to come home.

What if fasting is not about emptying yourself but about refusing to consume your way through fear? The world's answer to crisis is more noise, more distraction and more information. Fasting says: I refuse. I am bringing my hunger to God and letting Him fill it. That is a declaration of dependence, and dependence on God is the only solid ground there is.

So, let the Church be what she was always meant to be - not a bunker for the frightened, but a school for the brave. Not a place where we hide from the world's pain, but where we learn to carry it without being crushed, because the One at the centre of our gathering has already borne the worst the world can do, and risen.

Thoughts to Ponder

- 1) Where is the loudest war happening inside you right now - and have you brought it to God, or are you still trying to negotiate it alone?
- 2) What is the first thing you reach for when morning comes and the world is uncertain? What would it look like to reach for God first?
- 3) If fasting is refusing to consume your way through fear, what are you currently consuming instead of praying? What would you gain by exchanging it for silence before God?

Peace be with us.
